4. All participants must attend an **Orientation Meeting on Saturday, February 3rd from 12:30-2:00 PM at H<sub>2</sub>O** (see address above) There you will be assigned coaches and practice times, both of which are **mandatory** to enter this tournament.

# Rules and Regulations

## Registration

- Teams will consist of no more than 6 players and no less than 4, with only 3 on the court at any given time.
- Any high school student with in good standing (grades, behavior, attendance, etc.) can participate.
- Registration must be done in advance by turning in a copy of the Player Registration Form and returning it to Heart Haven OutReach (H<sub>2</sub>O), 201 Canterbury Lane Suite C, Bolingbrook, IL 60440 by Wednesday, January 31st.
- All players must have a completed Permission Slip & Release Form signed by their parent/legal guardian.
- All players must attend an Orientation Meeting on Saturday, February 3rd. Coaches and practice times will be assigned at that time.

## Practices

- Players must participate in at least 3 practices before the tournament.
- All practice times and locations will be determined by team coaches and must be facilitated by coaches.
- Any player unable to practice 3 times before the tournament will be disqualified from play unless excused by the coach.

## Game Play

- Play will consist of 2 teams of 3 players each competing on a half court.
- All teams are guaranteed at least 2 games.
- Points will be counted as the following: 3 points for shots outside the arc and 2 points for shots inside the arc.
- There will be at least one referee for each court.
- The start of the game will be determined by Rock, Paper, Scissors. The winning team gets the ball for the first half. The other team will receive the ball for the start of the second half.
- Games will consist of two running 10-minute halves with a 3-minute half time. Three 30 second time-outs per game is allowed per team. For the last minute of each half, time may be stopped by the referee's whistle (i.e., ball goes way out of bounds and is taking longer to retrieve). Teams not on the court at game time will forfeit the match.
- On defensive rebounds or steals, players must return the ball by dribble or pass across the three point line before a basket may be attempted. Once across the line, they do not have to pass the ball before shooting.
- After a basket, the team scored upon will put the ball in play.
- Any intentional foul (determined by the referee) on a shooting player will result in 1 point rewarded to the shooting team.
